Our Course Rotation

- Our course rotation attempts to take advantage of faculty expertise across all our content areas: Interpersonal Communication (IPC), Intercultural Communication (ICC), Organizational Communication (ORG), Rhetoric and Critical/Cultural Studies (RCC), Health Communication (HEA), and Performance Studies (PS).
- We create our schedule with input from all graduate faculty – and with a strong focus on needs of current students.
- Adjustments to the schedule may be necessary because of unanticipated or changing circumstances (faculty sabbaticals/research leaves, new faculty joining our School, shifting student interests/needs, low enrollment in some areas, etc.).
- Our course rotation includes:
 - Core Courses: Intro to Com Theory (COM 604) & 3 Research Method Courses (COM 607, 608, 609)
 - Survey Courses: Each content area provides an overview of important theories and research defining the area
 - Special Topic Seminars: In-depth examinations of specific areas of research and practice
 - Modules: Single-credit courses that focus on specialized research methods, theories, pedagogies, or applications
 - Introductory Research Courses: Offered for those who need a starter course before taking advanced methods
